



**Scottish Sprint & Hillclimb Championship Club  
Supplementary Regulations  
June Boyndie Sprint  
26<sup>th</sup> / 27<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

1. Scottish Sprint & Hillclimb Championship Club Ltd will organise a RS Interclub status sprint on 26<sup>th</sup> / 27<sup>th</sup> June 2021 at Grampian Kart Club, Boyndie by Banff. This event will use Circuit 1 layout, which is a tarmac surface, 825m long and consists of 1.8 laps.
2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations, and the Guyson Scottish Sprint Championship Regulations.
3. An MSUK Permit has been applied for.
4. The event is open to all fully elected members of the organising club, and members of all Motorsport UK recognised clubs in Scotland.
5. All competitors must produce a valid competition licence, club membership card and the appropriate vehicle documentation. The club would like to remind all potential entrants that a R.S Interclub is the minimum licence requirement.
6. The event will also include two rounds of the 2021 Guyson Scottish Sprint Championship, one round of the 2021 Scottish Speed Championship, two rounds 2021 Blackadder's Highland Speed Championship and two rounds of XBC Cross-Border Championships.

8. The programme for the event will be as follows:  
 In line with current co-vid 19 guidelines ALL self – declaration forms will be required to be returned via e mail to the event secretary no less than 10 days before the event otherwise entries may be refused. Electronic signing on will take place between 3 -7 days before the event again in guidance with current co-vid19 guidelines. **Please note the restrictions on paddock and pit crew personnel due to co-vid (ie Driver + 3 all of whom must be named on the self – declaration form)**  
  
**Sorry no spectators allowed, although this may change before the event.**
9. Any competitor not signed on by 09.30hrs may be excluded from the event.

12. Competitors will start singly. The Method of Timing will be electronic, and the start signal will be a green light. The finish line will be indicated by a chequered flag.
13. Competition cars will be identified with competition numbers. **It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their car is numbered appropriately.**
14. On each day, competitors will have the opportunity to practice (in accordance with S2.1.1) followed by three timed runs. Competitors must walk the course prior to commencement of practice runs.
15. Awards for the event will be presented as follows:  
Overall Fastest Time

#### Class Awards

- 1<sup>st</sup> in Class
- 2<sup>nd</sup> in Class (where there are more than 5 competitors in a class)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> in Class (where there are more than 10 competitors in a class)

The above awards will be presented at the conclusion of the meeting each day

16. Provisional Results will be displayed at the main event control office. If viewing these social distancing MUST be observed.
17. The maximum entry for the meeting is 70 and the minimum is 50. The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary and reserve the right to cancel the meeting should minimum numbers not be met.
18. Entries for the event open on receipt of these regs , and close at noon on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2021.
19. **The entry fee for the event is £200, for the weekend. Entry fee for one day is £100.**
20. Entries will be confirmed by email unless otherwise stated on the entry form. This also applies to Final Instructions and Results.
21. Any Competitor withdrawing from an event less than 72 hrs before the start of the event may be subject to an administration fee of £50.
22. Red Flag signals will be in accordance with S9.3.7 (b). Q15.1 (j) does not apply.
23. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5, accompanied by the appropriate protest fee.
24. A Timing Strut in accordance with S.10.9.1 is required. Checks may be carried out in accordance with D25.1.4, D35.1, G15.1.4 and H39 regarding the use of alcohol and/or drugs.
25. Tyre Warming is banned at Boyndie Circuit
26. Competitors must note that any competitor-recorded videos are the property of the MSUK and may have to be surrendered as required by MSUK's rules.

**END OF SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY AS IT DETAILS IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE WAY THAT MOTORSPORT EVENTS NOW HAVE TO BE ORGANISED**

In accordance with Motorsport UK and Scottish Government COVID-19 guidance the following new procedures are being introduced:

- Everyone attending the event must be well and NOT exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Social distancing, wearing of face masks and use of hand sanitiser gel must be maintained at all times in the paddock.
- Spectators are NOT allowed at the event, but this may change later
- ALL event documentation will be in digital form ONLY. Paper copies of documents will NOT be accepted.
- Competitors will be required to complete a *Competitors Signing-On* form which will be circulated with the Final Instructions and must be returned to the Entries Secretary by 19:00 hrs on Wednesday 23 June 2021. This form will include a declaration that the competitor is not exhibiting any symptoms of Covid-19 and record their mobile telephone number for use if necessary in contact and trace.
- Only three additional persons per competitor will be allowed as a mechanics, who should (if possible) travel in a separate vehicle if they are not a member of the same household. Their name and contact telephone number must be provided on the *Competitors' Signing-On* form (see above)
- Competitors' overnight camping should be allowed.
- Food and drink will be available at the cafe.
- To accommodate social distancing, the paddock area has been increased in size and will include gravel / grassed area. Final Instructions will include locations within the paddock and the surface type.
- Social distancing must be maintained between driver and mechanic where possible, and they must use PPE as appropriate.
- A Drivers Briefing will not take place at the event but will be provided in writing with the Final Instructions.
- Competitors should ensure they have sufficient PPE with them and bring their own first aid kit.
- Please be aware that our paddock marshals have been instructed to monitor social distancing as part of COVID-19 regulations and will advise competitors if they feel that this is not being maintained. Any abuse of the paddock marshals or other officials will be reported to the Clerk of the Course, and could lead to the offender(s) being removed from the event.
- **Competitors must ensure they leave the paddock tidy and take home all their own rubbish.**
